Global Programmes Working for Women

Women and their families in developing countries need support and resources and UNIFEM provides innovative projects to help alleviate the problems they face. Through its fundraising activities, UNIFEM UK provides contributions for these projects and also collects donations that go directly to specific projects with no part being retained for administration. Contributions are invited from individuals, organisations and companies. Thank you in anticipation of your generosity.

(1) Trust Fund to End Violence Against Women

UNIFEM's Trust Fund serves as a grant making laboratory for new strategies and best practices to eliminate gender-based violence. An example of projects supported includes a soap opera produced in Nicaragua, a highly popular programme that gives a clear message to teenagers of their rights to make their own decisions and stop gender-based violence and discrimination. UNIFEM receives many more excellent proposals that it has funds to support.

(2) Formation and Capacity Building of HIV/AIDS Positive Women's Networks in Guandong Province, China

Guandong Province has large numbers of women infected with HIV/AIDS. The project will support the formation of HIV/AIDS positive women's networks, building their capacity through knowledge sharing and access to information on healthcare and treatment, and facilitate links with policy makers/service providers to improve gender health service for HIV/AIDS positive women.

(3) Support to Women's Entrepreneurial Activities in Morocco

UNIFEM plans to promote partnership between women's entrepreneurship NGOs and government regional centres to provide gender sensitive services for women's economic activities.

(4) Gender Justice and Women's Rights in Uganda

The 20-year civil conflict in Northern Uganda has brought with it gross violations of women's rights, especially sexual violence and abduction of girls. UNIFEM, in collaboration with UNDP, will support a gender expert in Kampala to work with NGOs and civil society organisations and the Ministry of Gender to advocate policies and legislation to address gender based violence.

(5) Support to Women's Participation in Public Policy Formulation at the Municipal Level, Mexico

UNIFEM will strengthen its effort to open doors for women's participation in governance at the local level. The project will promote women's participation and leadership to engender public policy at the local level and link local advocacy to national efforts to incorporate and implement CEDAW in Mexico.

(6) Support to Women's Centres in Afghanistan

UNIFEM has been working in Afghanistan since early 2002 to build Afghan women's capacities and leadership for their effective participation in social, economic and political rebuilding of the country. As part of this programme, UNIFEM is working with the Ministry of Women's Affairs to support the establishment of centres in the provinces to provide a range of services including income generation, health education, literacy, micro-credit, vocational training, psychosocial services and child care.
